At the January meeting, we will enjoy a game of daylily trivia. This should be a fun evening and we hope the weather is cooperative.


Ray Clark has agreed to give us a presentation on the production and preservation of vital seeds and the role of the seed bank at the February meeting.

President Carrithers called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm. Kathy Brown of Oldham County Master Gardeners, a guest of Andrea King, was introduced.

There being no alterations needed, the minutes of the September meeting were approved as they appeared in the October newsletter.

The October Treasurer's Report was presented to the members. Karen Sidebottom moved to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion was seconded by Michael Stephens and approved by the members.

December 08, 2016

The Holiday meeting of the Louisville Area Daylily Society was held December 08, 2016 at Trinity

Presbyterian Church, Middletown, Kentucky. Members gathered at 6:30 pm to enjoy an excellent holiday buffet and social time prior to the business meeting. Sliced ham was provided by the club and members contributed a wide variety of delicious side dishes and desserts.

President Carrithers called the meeting to order at 7:45 pm. She welcomed all of the members to the meeting and went on to announce that Chris Schardein's father had passed away the day before. Sincere condolences go out to her and her family.

The minutes from the October meeting had not been distributed yet so could not be approved. They will be included in the December Newsletter.

The November Treasurer's Report was presented to the members. There were no questions, so David Kirchhoff moved to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion was seconded by Susan Holt approved by the members.

President Carrithers announced that a new AHS publication will be available shortly. This one is called Open Form Daylilies - Spiders, Unusual Forms and Other "Exotics". They will be available through the clubs for \$20 each. A sign-up sheet was circulated for members to request a copy. She also indicated that we have a couple of copies of earlier publications still available. Please contact Ellen Carrithers if you are interested in purchasing one.

President Carrithers noted that the Region 10 Mid-Winter Symposium will be held in Nashville, TN on February 10 – 12, 2017. David Kirchhoff is the Chair of the event and indicated there will be a number of excellent speakers, including several hybridizers. He said there will be social time Friday afternoon before the formal activities begin and there will be a daylily auction that evening. This will be a great "daylily fix" to help us get through a cold winter!

President Carrithers also announced that Indianapolis will be hosting the Region 2 Mid-Winter meeting. It will be held February 24 – 26, 2017.

President Carrithers then introduced Vice President Andrea King to speak on behalf of the Nominating Committee. She indicated that we've had some difficulty finding members who were willing to serve as officers. She presented the following nominations: Ellen Carrithers has agreed to continue as President for another year, Becky Scarboro has agreed to accept the role of Vice President, Linda Luck has agreed to retain the role of Secretary and Andrea King will accept the role of Treasurer. Susan Holt has also agreed to continue to be responsible for publishing the Newsletter on-line. We will have to suspend the Bi-Laws regarding the limit of a two year term for these nominations to be acceptable. John Morgan moved that the Bi-Laws regarding the two year term limit be suspended and his motion was seconded by Sally Fensterer. It was approved by the membership by acclimation.

There were no additional nominations from the floor. The election was by a show of hands and the officers presented were elected unanimously. Officers were then installed by Doris Stonska.

President Carrithers announced that we will hold our January meeting on January 19, 2017. Historically, we have held our meetings as long as the Jefferson County Schools were not cancelled for weather-related concerns. According to Andrea King however, she has contacted two possible speakers for the January and February meetings, both from out of state. If they can get here, we want to plan to hold the meetings regardless of what the school system has decided for the day. Andrea also has a back-up possibility for the speaker if neither of the out of state speakers can make the trip.

President Carrithers announced that we will hold our meetings at Trinity Presbyterian Church January through April, and plan to meet in members' gardens May through August, returning to the church after that.

President Carrithers reminded us that Sally Fensterer has agreed to coordinate the Hybridizers Reward Program this year. Please send Sally an email if you have any hybridizers you would particularly like her to contact.

There being no other business brought forward, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm. The meeting was followed by the raffle of several lovely poinsettias.
