#### April 20, 2017

The April meeting of the Louisville Area Daylily Society was held April 20, 2017 at Trinity Presbyterian Church, Middletown, Kentucky. We began the evening by enjoying social time and a variety of pot luck dinner items prepared by our members.

President Carrithers called the meeting to order at 7:20 pm. She welcomed all of the members to the meeting and made note that we had a few people back that we had not seen in a while.

#### President Carrithers made a few announcements:

- Blooming Bardstown Garden Tour is June 10<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 to 4:00. Much of the festival is free, but there is a charge to visit the gardens.
- Yew Dell Gardens Plant Sale is April 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>. We will be selling daylilies there so Wednesday April 26<sup>th</sup> we will dig them from the garden at Doris Stonska's. Set up for the sale is expected to be Friday the 28<sup>th</sup> but there will be more information provided about the time.
- The May meeting will be the HRP daylily distribution and it will be held at Linda Luck and Ray Clark's home at 4401 Starlite Lane in Louisville. It will start at 6:30 p.m. If anyone cannot attend,

The May meeting of the Louisville Area Daylily Society was held May 18, 2017 at the home of Linda Luck and Ray Clark at 4401 Starlite Lane in Louisville, Kentucky. We began the evening by enjoying social time and a variety of pot luck dinner items prepared by our members. Members also enjoyed a few minutes to wander around the gardens before the meeting began.

President Carrithers called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm. She welcomed all of the members to the meeting and gave a special welcome to Elaine Oette, who was with us as a guest of Donna Willett.

The Treasurer's report was distributed by email. Donna Willett moved that it be accepted and Doris Stonska seconded the motion. The Report was approved as presented. There were no Minutes distributed for the April meeting but they will be included in the next Newsletter.

President Carrithers reminded us about our bus trip to Cincinnati on Saturday June 3<sup>rd</sup>. The bus is LEAVING at 7:30 a.m. from the parking lot (rear) of Norton's Brownsboro Hospital. The parking lot entrance is between the hospital and Lowe's just off of Highway 22. Go past Lowe's and turn into the first entrance to the

hospital. The bus will be parked in the back. We will be visiting three nurseries and will have lunch at a barbecue restaurant. Water and muffins will be provided during our drive north and dessert will be provided on the drive back home. We expect to be back about 6:00 p.m.

President also reminded us that the Frank Otte Plant Sale will be Saturday August 5<sup>th</sup>.

We then proceeded to distribute this year's HRP daylilies by lottery. The plants were hybridized and provided by Bob Selman of Blue Ridge Daylilies in North Carolina. They were all a minimum of double fans and were very strong and healthy-looking plants. As a reminder, we grow the daylilies for two years, then return a double fan at the August meeting to be auctioned to other members.


Our next meeting will be JUNE 29<sup>th</sup> (a week later than usual due to National) and will be held at Becky Scarboro and Nelson Ratchford's home at 5503 Cross Creek Drive in Crestwood. It will start at 6:30 p.m.

President Carrithers then shared her favorite daylily planting recipe with us. She uses it to water the daylilies when she first plants them and it helps with their initial health. To one gallon of water she adds 1 Cup Sprite or 7Up (not diet), 1 Cup brewed tea, 1 Cup Listerine or store brand yellow mouthwash (the original, not with the mint flavor), and ½ teaspoon Superthrive plant food (from Wal-Mart.) You can soak the new plant's roots in it for a little while (up to a day) and then use it for the first watering.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 8:00 p.m.


