The June meeting of the Louisville Area Daylily Society was held June 29, 2017 at the home of Becky Scarboro and Nelson Ratchford at 5503 Cross Creek Dr. in Crestwood, Kentucky. We began the evening by wandering through their beautiful gardens. This was followed by a very tasty buffet dinner prepared and provided entirely by Becky and Nelson.

Prior to the start of the business meeting, Richard Porter announced that DSL would be holding a daylily show and sale at the MidCity Mall on Saturday July 1st. It's an accredited show and everyone is welcome to show their daylilies. They will also have a variety of daylilies for sale, with the sale starting at 11:00 a.m. There will also be DSL members present to offer tips on grooming daylilies for show.

President Carrithers called the meeting to order at 7:35 pm. She welcomed all of the members to the meeting and

gave Donna Willett and Linda Luck each the opportunity to introduce their guests to the members.

There was no Treasurer's Report distributed but according to Treasurer Andrea King, there were no changes from the last report. The Minutes from both the April and May meetings were in the Newsletter. Donna Willett moved that they be accepted and Claudia Wolff seconded the motion.

Hubert Glass had invited members to his home for a cookout on July 8th, but President Carrithers announced he had notified her that he needed to postpone the event due to some health issues. He will keep her posted on how he is doing. We want to please keep him in our thoughts and prayers.

Michael Stephens announced that he has been working on the LADS website and it has now been converted from DaylilyFans to PlantFans. The site is now LADS.PlantFans.com. The Newsletters will be included under the category "Blog." The HRP lists are under the HRP option and are listed by hybridizer's name. The plants in the LADS daylily bed are there and we want to make sure the pictures are included as well. If you go to the old website it will automatically link you to the new website.

President reminded us that the Frank Otte Plant Sale will be Saturday August 5th. That prompted Nancy Smith to say she had been by the site and it looked empty. During the ensuing discussion, it was learned that the Frank Otte nursery on Shelbyville Road is now permanently closed. Andrea King will check with the Frank Otte nursery on Bardstown Road to see if they are

willing to let us have the sale there. She and Ellen Carrithers as well as other officers will pursue other options if they are not available, but we don't have much time to make other arrangements.

Since we are not doing the cook-out on July 8th, it was suggested and agreed that we will work at the LADS daylily bed doing some weeding that morning. The bed is located at Doris Stonska's home and gardens at 8032 N. Watterson Trail in Louisville. We will also sell daylilies out of the bed while we are there. The sale will run from 9:00 a.m. until noon.

President Carrithers announced that our July meeting will be held at Doris Stonska's home and the August meeting will be at Karen Sidebottom's home. The HRP Auction will be held at the August meeting as usual. As a reminder, members are expected to return a double fan of each of their Clements hybridized daylilies (from the May 2015 distribution) as well as a double fan of any past due HRP daylilies.

We are planning on having Lucas Holmes as our speaker at the September meeting. Due to Lucas' work schedule, he has said a Saturday would work best for him, but that is currently being determined. More information will be provided about that at a later date.

Claudia Wolff announced that the next DSL meeting will have an Extension Agent as the speaker and everyone is invited to attend. They will meet on the third Monday in July at the Church of the Nazareth off of Smyrna Road.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 8:20 p.m. and was followed by a door prize raffle of a variety of plants.
