John Morgan gave a very informative presentation on the origins of the Waterfront Botanical Gardens and the part that Helen Harrigan and so many others have played over the years trying to get a Botanical Garden in Louisville. It has taken 22 year for Helen's vision to be realized. Some time ago John, and several individual LADS members purchased one side of one of the pillars at the Education Center in the name of LADS. Recently John purchased the other side of the same pillar for LADS. Thank you John. John also explained that the original plans for the Helen Harrigan Memorial Daylily Garden have changed. Waterfront wants swaths of the same color daylily rather than a wide variety of cultivars. As plans progress we will hear more about the various colors that are wanted and members can respond if they have the desired color or cultivar. Stay tuned for more information on this.

Next Cleo Philon gave his report on our Hybridizer Reward Program for 2020. Doug Sterling, Tom Polston and Jamie Gossard will be providing the plants this year. Doug Sterling & Tom Polston are sending the following daylilies:

2018 Introductions – 6 cultivars 2017 Introductions – 6 cultivars 2016 Introductions – 6 cultivars Jamie Gossard is sending 2020 Introductions of 18 cultivars.

This will give HRP a total of 36 cultivars for our LADS members. Cleo, thank you for getting these fine hybridizers to participate in our program.

Phil Raisle then gave a brief overview of the upcoming Hosta College to be held at Pique, OH on March 20th and 21st. The website for registration and information is:

www.ihostohio.org The cost is \$48.00 for members and \$57.00 for nonmembers. This year there will be 65 different classes on all aspects of gardening with hostas.

Kathy Brown asked if members receive Easter Seal stickers and are willing to part with them, we could use them for the Summer Meeting.

-Region 10 daylilies for Convention "gift bourbon barrel"


We will have materials prepared and "stuff the Convention folders" at our May meeting so everyone can have an opportunity to help.




Daylilies with companion plants
